Energy Saver Rebate - The Energy Saver Rebate is available to Fix-up Fund borrowers who complete approved energy improvements with their Fix-up Fund loan proceeds and apply for a rebate within a specified period of time. The rebate is 35% of eligible loan proceeds, up to \$10,000. At least one person per lending partner organization must participate in a training session to be eligible to process rebates under an Energy Saver Rebate agreement with Minnesota Housing.
