### Energy Saver Rebate Update

#### Launch Date and Program Change

Beginning Thursday, September 30, lenders may commit Fix-up Fund loans eligible for Energy Saver Rebates. An additional \$2 million is available from federal funding for this program.

Rebates up to \$10,000 are available for eligible improvements using a Fix-up Fund loan. One Energy Saver Rebate allowed per household.

- Windows and doors now qualify for a **25%** Rebate of the cost financed with a Fix-up Fund loan.
- All other previous Rebate-eligible improvements continue to qualify for a **35%** Rebate of the costs financed with a Fix-up Fund loan.
