### Minnesota Housing seeks public comment on NSP3 Action Plan

The federal government has made available to the State of Minnesota \$5 million of Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP3) funding for foreclosure remediation activities in areas of greatest need, which include the cities of Minneapolis, St. Paul, and Big Lake, and the counties of Anoka, Dakota, Hennepin and Ramsey. An amendment to the 2010 Action Plan (Amendment) is required for the State to receive the funds.

A draft of the Amendment will be available for public review and comment between January 14, 2011 and January 30, 2011.
