

Applicants' proposals for the Manufactured Housing Community Redevelopment Program for 2020 will be reviewed and scored on selection criteria that include:

1. **Infrastructure Needs** (0-20 points) – based on critical need, health & safety issues identified by local authority, and infrastructure converted to public utilities.
2. **Acquisition Scoring** (0-20 points) – based on converting communities to cooperative ownership models, the risk of park closure or the risk of the park being converted to other uses.
3. **Households Served and Project Assessment** (0-20 points) – based on applicant demonstrating how the Project will benefit low- to moderate- income households, communities occupied by year-round residents, and application containing a complete infrastructure assessment and/or appraisal and purchase contract.
4. **Project Leverage and Costs** (0-20 points) – based on amount of leverage, leverage sources from local municipality, project cost, and project feasibility based on applicant and contractor experience.

Applications for Infrastructure **or** Acquisition will be scored on a range of up to 60 points.

Applications for **both** Infrastructure and Acquisition will be scored on a range of up to 80 points.
