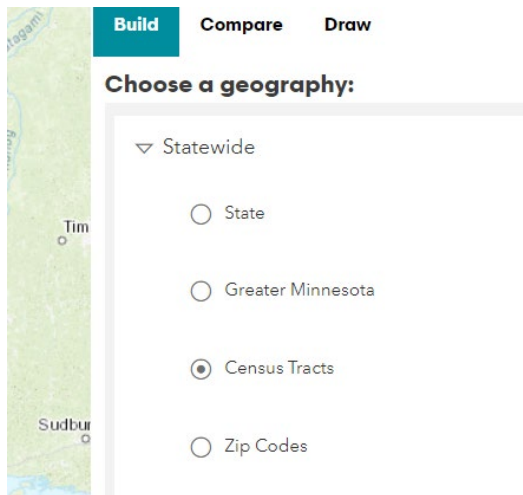


Instructions: How to Find Demographic Information

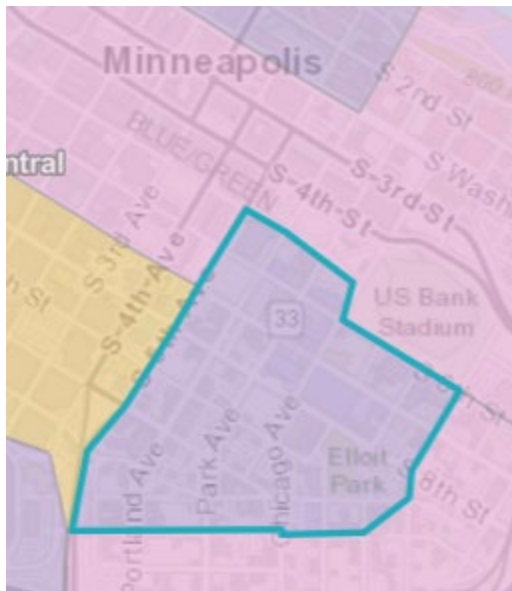
1. Go to [MN Compass](#).
2. Go to “Choose a geography”.
3. Click on the little triangle next to “Statewide”; A drop down menu will appear.
4. Select “Census Tracts”.



5. Click on the area of Minnesota map where the building is located.
6. Use the “+” sign in the top left corner of the map to zoom into your community. **Note:** you can click and drag the map to move it.



7. Continue to zoom in until your census tract is located.



- Make sure only one census tract is selected, and it is the correct one then click on the “View Profile” button to the right of the map.

- Scroll down to “Race & Ethnicity (2018-2022)”.

Race & Ethnicity (2018-2022)	Census Tract 1054	
White	2,299	60.8%
Of Color	1,402	37.1%
Black or African American alone	855	22.6%
American Indian and Alaskan Native alone	suppressed	
Asian or Pacific Islander alone	184	4.9%
Other alone	suppressed	
Two or more races alone	129	3.4%
Hispanic or Latino (of any race)	221	5.8%

- Calculate the percentage of the population that is Black, Indigenous and people of color by taking 100% - percentage of the population that is white. In the above example $100\% - 60.8\% = 39.2\%$.
