- 24 CFR Part 92

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Section 3 Overview



- Provision of the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Act of 1968
- Purpose is to ensure that employment shall, to the greatest extent feasible, be directed to low- and very low-income persons
- Applies to projects receiving over \$200,000

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Section 3 Overview

Numerical Goals

- At least 30 percent of aggregate new hires of recipients, contractors and subcontractors for the year are Section 3 residents
- At least 10 percent of the total dollar amount of all Section 3 covered contracts for building trade work is awarded to Section 3 business conserve.
- At least 3 percent of the total dollar amount of all other Section 3 covered contracts is awarded to Section 3 business concerns (e.g., architectural or accounting services required by a construction contract)

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MBE/WBE Overview

- Provision under state of Minnesota and federal procurement standards
- Applies to projects receiving over \$25,000



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MBE/WBE Overview

Minnesota Housing's Participation Goals

MBE:

- Twin Cities metro: 13 percent of the total amount of all contracts
- Greater Minnesota: 4 percent of the total amount of all contracts

• WBE:

• Entire state: 6 percent of the total amount of all contracts




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
