- New construction, including demolition or removal of existing structures with rebuild
- Acquisition, rehabilitation and resale of existing housing
- Construction financing and gap financing
- Lending products for individuals

# Case Study: Cass Clay Community Land Trust

**Project:** Affordable Housing Initiative

**Developer**: Cass Clay CLT in partnership with Lake Agassiz Habitat for Humanity

What It Funds: New Construction and Affordability Gap/Downpayment & Closing Costs Assistance

Who It Serves: Moderate income homebuyers making up to \$80,000



#### Impact Fund: Fund Types

- Interim construction financing
  - Provided to developers
  - · Short-term, low-interest bearing
  - Assist with acquiring, demolishing, rehabilitating or constructing owneroccupied housing
- Deferred forgivable loans
  - Provided to homebuyers and homeowners
  - Interest-free, deferred, forgivable
  - Help homebuyers bridge affordability gaps or fund homeowners' rehabilitation costs

#### Grants

- Bridge value gaps between project's total development costs and fair market value
- For other eligible activities where recapture of funds is infeasible or unaffordable

#### **Community Partnerships**

- Partnerships establish connection to community
- Partners can include local government, lenders, contractors, homebuyer educators, realtors, etc.
- Strengthens organizational capacity
- Demonstrates project readiness

### A Continuum of Programs

- Homeownership Capacity: Help families improve their financial position
- HECAT: Educate families about the homebuying process and homeownership
- Downpayment & Closing Costs Loans for income-eligible homebuyers.
- Impact Funds: Help developers construct homes for families to purchase
- Impact Funds: Provides affordability gap for families to purchase homes
- Impact Funds: Provides rehabilitation dollars for existing homeowners to fix their homes

# Homeownership Education Counseling And Training (HECAT) Fund and Homeownership Capacity

- Funding Type: Grants
- Process: Biannual Request for Proposals, next anticipated RFP release: 2025
- Eligible Uses
  - **HECAT**: Homebuyer Education Classes, One-on-One Homebuyer Education Services, Foreclosure Prevention Counseling and Home Equity Conversion Counseling
  - Homeownership Capacity: Financial Education, Financial Coaching and Post-Program Completion Services
- Eligible Applicants: Nonprofit Organizations, Local Units of Government and Tribes or Tribal Entities

#### Manufactured Home Community Redevelopment

#### **Manufactured Home Community Redevelopment Program**

- Funding Type: Grants
- Next Funding Availability: Summer 2025
- Eligible Uses
  - Infrastructure improvements such as sewer systems, storm shelters, street improvements, electrical upgrades
  - Acquisition of manufactured home parks
- Eligible Applicants Manufactured home communities owned by:
  - Indigenous Tribes or Tribal Entities such as Tribal Housing Redevelopment Authorities
  - Cooperatively Owned, Nonprofit Intermediaries, Individuals, Corporate Entities
