Rehabilitation Loan Program and Emergency & Accessibility Loan Program Income Limit Changes

The Rehabilitation Loan Program and Emergency & Accessibility Loan Program (RLP/ELP) income limits will increase effective **May 3, 2021**.

The following income limits are effective for loans locked on or after May 3, 2021:

Household Size	Income Limit
1 Person	\$22,100
2 Person	\$25,200
3 Person	\$28,400
4 Person	\$31,500
5 Person	\$34,000
6 Person	\$36,500
7 Person	\$40,200
8 Person	\$44,700
9 Person	\$49,200
10 Person	\$53,800
11 Person	\$58,300
12 Person	\$62,900

If you receive an income error while locking a loan in Minnesota Housing's loan commitment system, confirm that the borrower is income eligible and contact [Tonya Taylor](mailto:Tonya.Taylor@mnhousing.gov) at 651.296.8844 to proceed with the loan.
