Fix Up Rate Review & Adjustment Coming July 1

As a reminder, Fix Up rates are reviewed and adjusted on the first day of the quarter in January, April, July, and October. The next rate review and adjustment will take place on July 1. It is essential that lenders lock loans in their pipeline if you want to take advantage of the rate prior to the change.
